Budget Increases and Projects

\$45,136	Security: Increased cost for 4 Class III officers, extended school year security, after-school security guard		
\$738,000	<u>Labor Negotiation/ Personnel:</u> Negotiation and substitute personnel increase.		
\$784,000	<u>Health Insurance</u> : Increase in health benefits (15.1%).		
\$128,000	PERS (Division of Pension): Increase in PERS for non-certificated staff.		
\$453,245	Increase in Special Education Costs: Mental/behavioral health; tuition and personnel		
\$50,000	<u>Unanticipated Placements for Charter school</u> – Four unanticipated charter school students.		
\$122,000	<u>Utilities and Fuel Costs</u> : Increase in utilities and fuel cost.		
\$138,000	RVA Lease (\$248K): Lease cost for Riverview Annex - 248K cost for 23/24.		
\$88,100	<u>Technology</u> : Software license renewal; hardware support; network monitoring; FM System; Cameras		
	replacement; server upgrade; and other contingencies for repairs/replace technology.		
\$122,170	<u>Curriculum & Other</u> : Online books; library books; workbooks; Dreambox; Linklt Assessment, etc.		
\$3,303,000	Facilities: LV HVAC, masonry repairs; paving.		

Important Notes:

- The budget accounts for a 6.02% increase in the tax levy.
- This budget reflects an increase in State Aid in the amount of \$488K.
- The next 5-year strategic plan is scheduled for Board approval in May/June-2023.
- The administration continues working to bring in new revenue- Rentals, Tuition, Grants, etc.
- The District is Debt Free and continues improving the facilities utilizing capital and maintenance reserve.

Reminder - this budget represents the tax impact only for Denville PK-8 BOE - Town, County, and MHRD budgets are separate
